B4. BADEN-POWELL SCOUT GUILD. THE

B4.1 Statement.

B4.1.1 The Baden-Powell Scout Guild (“the B-P Guild”) is a fellowship of former Scouts, Guides and other interested persons whose principal ideal is maintaining the Scout and Guide ‘spirit’ in everyday life. The object of the Guild is to keep alive among its members the Scout and Guide Promise and Law, to carry that spirit into the communities in which they live and work and to support, as far as practicable, Scouting and Guiding in their communities.

B4.1.2 The Association encourages ex leaders to become a member of the Guild.

B4.1.3 Meetings.

B4.1.4.1 The Branch B-P Guild meets each third Monday night of the month at the Branch Headquarters and the incumbent Branch President of the B-P Guild is Mr Les Marshall.

B4 1 4 2 The State B-P Guild meets each third Tuesday morning of the month at the Branch Headquarters and the incumbent State Guild Master of the B-P Guild is Mr Bill Heel.

B4 1 4 The Baden-Powell Scout Guild badge is the Scout Badge in red superimposed on a white Guild badge.
