#### **B7. BADEN-POWELL HOUSE LONDON.**

##### **B7.1 Information.**

- B7.1.1 Accommodation is available at Baden-Powell House in London, England for all members of the Scout movement, their families and also members of Guides Australia.
- B7.1.2 The accommodation caters for a total of 180 people with a number of dormitories which range from holdings of 9 people to the biggest dormitory which provides for 19 people. Shower facilities and other services are situated on each residential floor. A self-service restaurant on the first floor is capable of seating 85 at each sitting and is open to residents and non-residents for breakfast, lunch and dinner. All meals should be booked in advance.
