M2. MEDALS.

M2.1 Statement.

- M2.1.1 The medals associated with Gallantry, Meritorious Conduct and Good Service Awards are normally worn on such Scouting occasions as Group, District or Branch Annual General Meetings, Scouting funerals (when attending in uniform), Good Service Award Ceremonies, Youth awards day and on any formal Scouting occasions where it is stated that scouting decorations should be worn.
- M2.1.2 Medals should also be worn when a Scouter is attending a State function as a representative of the Movement.
- M2.1.3 Refer to Policy & Rules R13 “Decorations and Awards” provides advice concerning the correct positioning of emblems, medals, etc on the uniform.
- M2.1.4 Given that the Silver Kangaroo is the highest acknowledgement of the Scouting Awards system, then the Branch Awards Committee should consider recommending a recipient receiving this award for a Civil Honour or Award.
- M2.1.4.1 The receipt of the Silver Kangaroo is not the only time that a recipient could be nominated for a Civil Honour or Award but by its very nature is cause enough to consider nomination.
- M2.1.4.2 Refer also to C1 Civil Honours and Awards for further information in relation to this process.
