#### **M4. MEMORABILIA MUSEUM.**

##### **M4.1 Statement.**

The Scout Association of Australia, Western Australian Branch (“the Association”) maintains a historical record of its operations since inception and this is managed by a volunteer team in the memorabilia museum.

M4.1.1 The memorabilia museum is located in Branch Headquarters at 581 Murray Street West Perth.

M4.2 The contents include meeting record books dating back to the first meeting in 1909, badge displays, uniforms of early to modern day Western Australia as well as a number of uniforms from overseas, a wide range of woggles, trophies, foundation stones from relinquished Scout Halls, numerous books and other items of historical significance.

M4.3 The memorabilia museum is open each Tuesday to Thursday from 10.00 am to 2.00pm, however, after hours openings are available by appointment and bookings may be made by contacting the Curator, through the Branch Office.

M4.3.1 Special arrangements are provided for country formations to access the Museum by appointment at times over the weekend and bookings are to be made by contacting the Curator.
