

GUIDELINES FOR MEMORIAL PLAQUES

**at the
MEMORIAL CAIRN
adjacent to the Web Green Chapel at
MANJEDAL**

PLAQUE MATERIAL

Plaques are to be manufactured from weather and ultraviolet resistant material. It is suggested they be made from a non-ferrous metal ie brass, copper or aluminium. Plastic is not recommended.

SIZE AND SHAPE

The plaque size is to be no greater than 100mm x 50mm in a landscape format. With a single screw hole in each corner.

FIXING

The plaque is to be affixed to the cairn by brass or equivalent non-ferrous screws through each corner.

The plaque ***MUST NOT BE GLUED*** to the cairn.

LETTERING

There is no restriction on the lettering applied to the plaque. However it is a requirement that the intent and wording is in fitting with the ethos of *Scouting*.

ASHES

Ashes may be placed around the cairn or the Chapel. However it must be understood that although the Assoc currently has tenure of the property it does not have ownership and subsequently there is a possibility that the area may in future no longer come under the Association's control.

SERVICES

It is recommended that if groups/parties are wishing to undertake a memorial service that the organiser confers with the Campsite Manager to ensure that there has not been another function organised that would conflict.

It is suggested that the plaque be affixed to the cairn before the service or dedication.

A Group scarf could be used as a shroud prior to an unveiling, were the plaque to be "unveiled"
