Welcome To Campwest 2011

Campwest 2011 will be held at Manjedal Scout Park, Nettleton Road, Byford from 2-8 October 2011.

It is a six day adventure camp for Scouts, qualifying Cub Scouts and Leaders.

At **Campwest 2011**, Scouts and Cubs will be placed in a **Campwest 2011** Troop and assisted by Scout Leaders. These Campwest troops form a large self-contained tent city. There will be new and exciting activities and challenges every day with entertainment each night and many opportunities to meet Scouts from all over the State, swap badges and make some really good friends.

Campwest 2011 is an excellent opportunity for Scouts to participate in the excitement and challenge of a big Scout camp and is valuable experience for any Scout who is considering attending AJ 2013 at Maryborough, Queensland.

Campwest 2011 Attendance Eligibility

Cub Scouts – to be at least 10½ years of age as at 1 September 2011 and linking to a Scout Group with the approval of the relevant Scout Leader

Scouts – to be older than 10½ and not yet 15 years of age as at 1 September 2011 and have the approval of the relevant Scout Leader

Venturers – to be a current member of a Venturer Unit and have the approval of the Unit Council

Rovers – to be a current member of a Rover Crew, hold a current and valid Working with Children Check Card and have the approval of your Rover Crew.

Leaders – to hold a current Certificate of Adult Membership in any Section, a valid Working with Children Check Card and have the approval of the relevant Group Leader or District Commissioner.



Campwest 2011 Fee Structure

Scouts	\$390
Venturers (reduced fee for assisting at the event)	\$200
Leaders/Rovers	\$150

Fees include the cost of camping, meals, onsite and offsite activities, entertainment and transport to and from activities. Scouts and Leaders are responsible for bringing their personal gear and a list itemising some suggested and required items will be forwarded after registration.
