29th April/Sri Lanka Scout Jamboree (April 2012)

This next major Asia-Pacific Region (APR) event is due to be held in Sri Lanka from 1-6 April 2012. The venue is Dambulla, located in the heart of Sri Lanka's Cultural Triangle. The Jamboree fee is a very reasonable USD150. Scouts aged from 12-17 years, and their troop line leaders are eligible to attend. International Service Team (IST) eligibility is 18-45 years. (fee USD100). Note that up to 3 nights home stay is available to international participants either pre or post-Jamboree.

Our recent returnees' from the 28th APR Jamboree in Taiwan (Matt, Heather, Joshua, Patrick and Eli from Rossmoyne-Shelley; and Joshua from Wembley Downs) will all tell you that this is an awesome opportunity to meet, greet and have fun with Scouts from across the Asia-Pacific Region. With the return airfares starting at just over \$650 per person, you can enjoy an exciting international Scouting experience, including home stay in a fascinating cultural setting, for as little as \$1,000.
